## Class of 2031

Kindergarten registration for the Lexington Schools will be held at Central Elementary and Western Elementary on Thursday, Feb. 22 from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 pm, 1:00-3:00 p.m., and 4:30-7:00 pm and Thursday, March 1 from 4:30 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. In order to be eligible for kindergarten your child must be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2018. The following documentation is needed for kindergarten registration:

- 1. Immunization record
- 2. Original birth certificate
- 3. Social Security card
- 4. Legal papers (single, adoptive, foster family or name change)
- 5. Proof of residence (rental, purchase agreement or current utility bill)
- 6. Your driver's license
