2024 All-Winter Sports Pass & Reserve Basketball Seat Information

Dear Lexington Fan:

We are presently getting ready for another exciting winter sports season! Our practices are underway, and the coaches and athletes are very excited about their upcoming seasons. At this time, you are being offered the first chance to purchase 2024-2025 passes and reserved basketball seats to get in on the excitement of our winter sports athletic contests. The price for these passes will remain the same, even though there has been an increase in single game ticket prices league wide to offset the ever-increasing cost of equipment, uniforms, and officials.

The **Adult All-Winter Sports Pass (\$85.00)** continues to be an excellent way to save money if you plan to attend more than 11 home high school contests. The **Student & Senior Citizen All-Winter Sports Pass (\$35.00)** will pay for itself by attending just 7 home high school contests. **As a reminder, the Adult/Student/Senior Citizen All-Winter Sports Passes can also be used for any high school and junior high contest, which further adds to the savings!**

Listed below are the new ticket prices for the 2024-2025 school year:

Varsity Contests: Adults - \$8.00 & Students/Senior Citizens - \$5.00

Stand Alone JV/Freshman/JH Contests: Adults - \$6.00 & Students/Senior Citizens - \$4.00

*Please note, Senior Citizens (65 years of age and older) that live within the Lexington Local School District **will still be admitted free of charge** when they present their new **“Minuteman Gold Card”** at the gate of any of our home athletic contests. We simply ask that those Senior Citizens that live within our district bring their driver’s license to the high school office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. starting on Monday, November 11th to pick up their “Minuteman Gold Card” if they did not get theirs during the fall season.

So as you decide which ticket option makes the most financial sense for you and your family, here are the opponents we will be welcoming into our facilities. This year we will be hosting 11 boys games in Ashland, Clear Fork, Dover, Berlin-Hiland, Madison, Mansfield Senior, New Philadelphia, Perkins, Cincinnati Princeton, West Holmes and Wooster. The girls slate will also offer 11 home games in Ashland, Clear Fork, Loudonville, Madison, Mansfield Senior, New Philadelphia, Old Fort, Ontario, West Holmes, Willard, and Wooster.
