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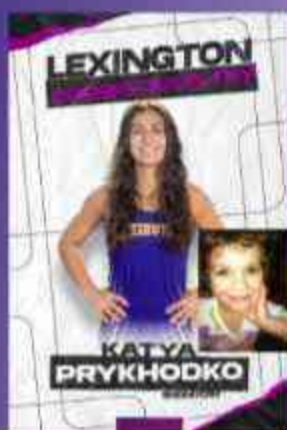
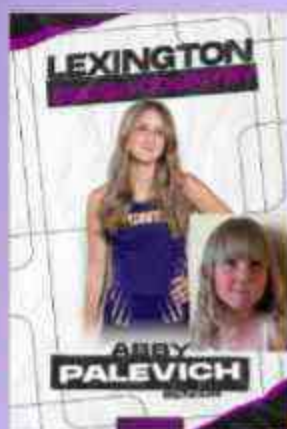
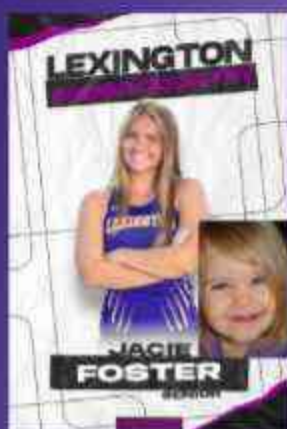
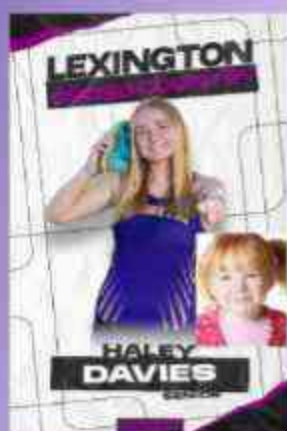
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2025 - 2026 FALL SEASON OUTLOOKS

POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION AND SUPPORTS (PBIS)

Fact Sheet

WHAT IS PBIS?

PBIS is a broad range of systematic and individualized strategies for achieving important social and learning outcomes in schools while preventing problem behavior.

CORE COMPONENTS OF PBIS:

Clear Expectations

School communities identify 3-5 school-wide overarching behavioral expectations.

Comprehensive Instruction

Systematic, explicit instruction, practice and feedback on the expected behaviors are provided in each school setting.

Supportive Structure

Teams focus on developing a setting in schools that provide effective academic and behavioral multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS) for all students.

Acknowledging and Correcting Behavior Systems

Consistency in acknowledging expected behaviors and correcting behavior errors is provided through:

- Active supervision
- Proactive scheduling
- Incentives and reinforcement
- Logical consequences and clear office referral procedures



PBIS AT LEXINGTON:

- PBIS teams have been established in each building and meet either monthly or bi-monthly. The district also has a PBIS team that meets monthly.
- Three clearly stated behavioral expectations: Be Respectful, Be Responsible, and Be Ready are enforced within all school settings.
- Quarterly incentives/rewards are given for students and staff who exhibit one or all of the expectations noted above.
- The district has implemented a multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS) framework to include behavior intervention and supports.
- In 2023, the district founded **Merry Minuteman** to serve Lexington families in need. If you would like to donate, please contact your building administrator.
- PBIS Shout-Outs QR codes can be found throughout the district to recognize staff and students for positive behaviors.

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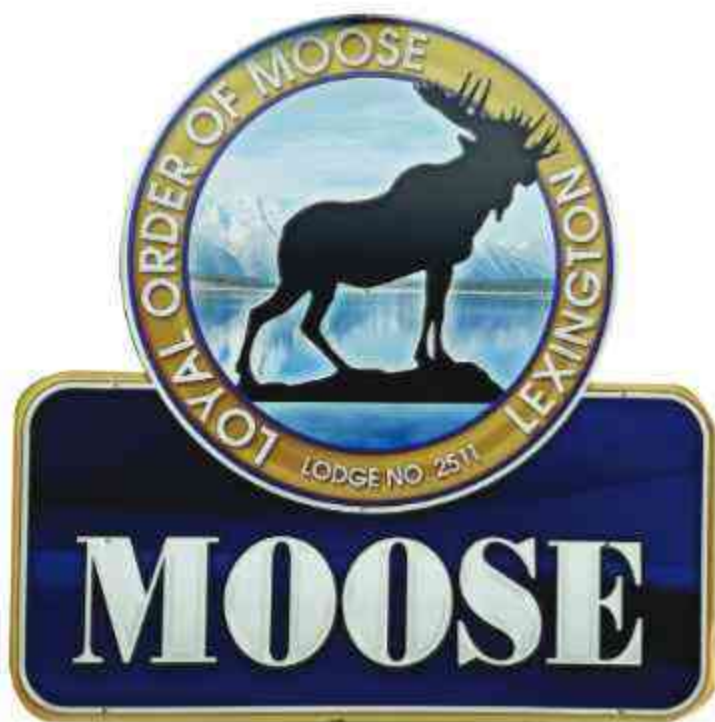
