**Student Services**

- Register to take the June 14th ACT by May 9th. Register online at act.org. This is your last opportunity to take the ACT during your junior year. September ACT deadline is in August. If you need special accommodations, you need to see your counselor.
- We are still waiting for some ACT results to come in, so if you did not receive your scores yet they will be coming. If you did not complete the final step to the ACT registration, you will need to call ACT to get your results and account set up.
- New and Current CCP students need to complete an Intent to Participate form. You have to complete each year. The deadline for this is April 1st every year. If you have not yet done so, please do it ASAP..
- OSU CCP application deadline for Fall 2025 is May 1<sup>st</sup>. Be sure you apply online and have all materials submitted (transcript) by the May 1st deadline.
- North Central State CCP applications should be completed online by June 1st.
- CCP applications to Bowling Green and Ashland should be completed online by May 15th. Students taking classes at the HS will be called down and walked through the application process. Ashland's will be next week. If you are taking a class that is not here at the HS, YOU need to register for those classes on your own.
- After submitting your applications, be sure to request a transcript from student services.
- Reminder for CCP and eligibility, if you are enrolled in a CCP course worth 3 credit hours, this will be worth 2 Eligibility Points.
- Eligibility for fall is dependent on your 4<sup>th</sup> – 9 weeks grades. Remember you need to be enrolled and pass 5 courses, ½ credit or more to be eligible to participate. PE does not count toward eligibility.
- If you are interested in participating in Division I or II athletics, please make sure to register with the NCAA as soon as possible. If you are looking at participating in athletics at an NAIA school, register with the NAIA Eligibility Center. The cost for each is \$100 and you must register online. If you have any questions, see your counselor.

- Remember you have 2 days excused for college/Military visits during your junior year and 2 during your senior year. We encourage you to get on campus if you have not done so already. Schedule a visit online with the college.
- Summer is a great time to get busy with your college search and application process. You should start your senior year with a list of 4-5 colleges where you want to apply.
- Be prepared for college applications: Common App – Get started ASAP. We will meet with you early next year to go over the application process and to answer any questions you might have. Now is also a great time to make sure that you can log onto your Naviance account. This is where you will request your transcripts to be sent along with your college applications
- Be thinking of teachers you would want to write a letter of recommendation for you. Ask them this spring, so they can start working on it over the summer.
- The last day to make a “change of mind” schedule change is April 25th.
- Remember to continue checking the Student Services Schoology and sign up for Class of 2026 remind. (@lex2026 to 81010) We include lots of valuable information about summer programs, scholarships, testing and other upcoming events. We also post a lot in your Class of 2026 schoology page. Make sure you are getting those announcements.
