- **PSAT: Oct 8th.** Deadline has passed to sign up (Monday) if you are still wanting to sign up please see me ASAP. Bring Chromebooks, fully charged. There will be limited availability to charge on test day. Check into 1st period for attendance and then report to the stage of the performing arts center
- **ASVAB Oct 10th,** Sign up in Student Services.
- ACT: Entire class will take in February. This is a free test. Practice tests and study guides can be found on the ACT website (myACT.org) If you would like to sign up for the test on any of the National testing dates, you can register through your myACT account.
- Don't forget to sign up for your AP test. Last day to indicate 'yes' or 'no' through your College Board account is **Nov 8th.** See your AP teacher or your counselor for your classroom join code if you have not created your College Board accounts. Tests are \$99. Any changes made after the Nov deadline will include a \$40 either a late fee or a cancellation fee.
