Graduation Attire

 - National Honor Society Cord / National Technical Honor Society Cord
 - Bio Club Cord

Class Speakers at Graduation

- There will be two student speakers at graduation
- Seniors will vote for one of the top five (5) students in their class. (Ranked by GPA)
- Seniors will vote from a list of students with a weighted GPA of 3.75 or higher and with at least two varsity awards in athletics, music or drama (or a combo equaling two or more)
- Details about voting will be shared via Remind in the near future

Your Chance to Thank and Invite

- Each graduating senior will have the chance to invite your most influential teacher/coach/counselor/person to graduation
- This person will have preferential seating at the ceremony
- The Lexington English department will share a document explaining this process
 - o Teachers will send the directions via Remind
 - Write a letter, inviting them to attend the ceremony
 - Turn the letter in by April 25th
