## Graduation Ceremony

- Each graduate will be given 10 tickets
  - You only need the tickets if it is raining and we are forced inside

## Graduation Attire

- Students are required to wear issued cap and gowns as well as approved school issued medals and/or cords
  - Personal, religious, political or other non-school-issued articles are not to be worn during the ceremony
  - Not all school issued cords are permitted during the ceremony
  - Approved medals / cords include:
    - High Honors Medal (GPA 3.75 and above)
    - Honors Medal (Gpa 3.50-3.75)
    - National Honor Society Cord / National Technical Honor Society Cord
    - Bio Club Cord

## Class Speakers at Graduation

- There will be two student speakers at graduation
- Seniors will vote for one of the top five (5) students in their class. (Ranked by GPA)
- Seniors will vote from a list of students with a weighted GPA of 3.75 or higher and with at least two varsity awards in athletics, music or drama (or a combo equaling two or more)
- Details about voting will be shared via Remind in the near future

### **Your Chance to Thank and Invite**

- Each graduating senior will have the chance to invite your most influential teacher/coach/counselor/person to graduation
- This person will have preferential seating at the ceremony
- The Lexington English department will share a document explaining this process
  - Teachers will send the directions via Remind
  - Write a letter, inviting them to attend the ceremony
  - Turn the letter in by April 25<sup>th</sup>
