Mrs. Eibon - Student Services

- PSAT: Oct 21st. The deadline is Friday, Oct 9th. Your English teachers should still have registration forms, if not, we have them available in student services. The test is \$18, and will be fully digital. This is a Practice SAT test. It is not mandatory, but is the only way to enter the National Merit Scholarship Competition.
- ASVAB Oct 20th, Sign up will be through Student Services (Remind and Schoology)
- ACT: Entire class will take in February. This is a free test. Practice tests and study guides can be found on the ACT website (myACT.org) If you would like to sign up for the test on any of the National testing dates, you can register through your myACT account. Sept 11th is the last day to register for their Oct 17th test date.
- Don't forget to sign up for your AP test. The last day to indicate 'yes' or 'no' through your College Board account is Nov 13th. See your AP teacher or your counselor for your classroom join code if you have not created your College Board accounts. Tests are \$99. Any changes made after the Nov deadline will also include a \$40 either a late fee or a cancellation fee.
- Student Services remind: text @lex2028 to 81010
- If you are not in your "class of 2028" schoology page, please let your counselor know so that we can add you. This is where we post about college tours, trips, scholarships, internships etc. The BGSU trip is now full, but sign ups for Aviation Days are still open.
