- C. ACT-sign up for Oct/Dec for your last chance b/f apps go out. Oct 17th test late registration by September 11th for the regular deadline. December 12th test; register by November 6. Practice tests and study guides can be found on the ACT website (ACT.org)

- E. College Visits, CommonApp, recommendations
- F. Naviance-all transcript requests through Naviance. See your counselor if you need help/need to set up your account
