Registration Timeline
<b>November - December:</b> Registration begins for the upcoming school year. Students will be given a copy of their course request sheet to take home for parental approval. Students/Parents may make schedule changes in the appropriate place on the registration form. Students must return the registration form with a parent(s) signature to their school counselor in Student Services.
Requests to change a schedule must be submitted no later than <b>February 27th</b> and require parental approval. "Change of mind" requests will not be honored after this date.
Schedule changes will only be made due to the following reasons:
<ul> <li>Schedule conflicts/errors</li> <li>Educational reasons: credit deficiencies or required courses needed</li> <li>Uneven balance of semester courses or study halls</li> <li>Changes due to completion of pre-approved summer school courses</li> <li>Changes that are in the long-range academic best interest of students will be considered with a consultation among student, parent, teacher, counselor and principal</li> <li>Second-semester changes: Any second semester schedule changes must meet the above criteria.</li> </ul>
To be fair and consistent with all students, we are sorry that we cannot entertain preferential requests for class periods, lunch period, or teachers.
<ul> <li>Students must be enrolled in 6 classes per semester.</li> <li>Students are allowed one Study Hall per semester.</li> <li>Students who have a full schedule (7 courses) will be permitted to drop a class for academic reasons at any time. Courses dropped after the first nine weeks will be noted with Withdrawal/Pass (WP) or Withdrawal/Fail (WF) on the transcript.</li> </ul>
Note: Students identified as gifted in a specific content area and/or superior cognition need to take a weighted or CCP course in their area of identification to receive gifted services. By not scheduling an eligible course, students are denying the services offered at Lexington HS.
