**Student Services**

- Register to take the June 13th ACT by May 8th. There is another one on July 11th, the deadline to register is June 5th. You must register online at act.org. These are your last opportunities to take the ACT during your junior year. September ACT deadline is in August. If you need special accommodations, you need to see your counselor.
- ACT results have come in from our February testing. If you did not receive your scores yet they should be coming soon. If you took the test with accommodations or on a make up date, they may not be in yet. If you did not complete the final step to the ACT registration, you will need to call ACT to get your results and account set up. You can stop into student services for more help.
- New and Current CCP students need to complete an Intent to Participate form. You have to complete each year. The deadline for this was April 1st. If you have not yet done so, please do it ASAP..
- OSU CCP application deadline for Fall 2026 is May 1<sup>st</sup>. Be sure you apply online and have all materials submitted (transcript, school counselor information form) by the May 1st deadline.
- North Central State CCP applications should be completed online by May 1st.
- Recommended due date for Ashland University CCP applications was April 1st. Please complete these ASAP. Students were called down on March 5th. If you missed that date, please see your counselor if you need help completing your application.
- CCP applications to Bowling Green and Ashland should be completed online by May 15th. Students were called down on March 17th. If you missed that date, please see your counselor if you need help completing your application.
- If you are planning to take a class that is not here at the HS, YOU need to register for those classes on your own. You will need to reach out to the college and see what is available, and then THEY will register you for that class. If that changes something that you requested here, please let your counselor know to update your requests and schedule for the fall.
- After submitting your applications, be sure to request a transcript from student services. If you need to submit test scores, you must do so from the ACT website or contact the college about taking the Accuplacer test.

- Reminder for CCP and eligibility, if you are enrolled in a CCP course worth 3 credit hours, this will be worth 2 Eligibility Points.
- Eligibility for fall is dependent on your 4<sup>th</sup> – 9 weeks grades. Remember you need to be enrolled and pass 5 courses, ½ credit or more to be eligible to participate. PE does not count toward eligibility.
- If you are interested in participating in Division I or II athletics, please make sure to register with the NCAA as soon as possible. If you are looking at participating in athletics at an NAIA school, register with the NAIA Eligibility Center. The cost for each is \$100 and you must register online. If you have any questions, see your counselor.
- Remember you have 2 days excused for college/Military visits during your junior year and 2 during your senior year. We encourage you to get on campus if you have not done so already. Schedule a visit online with the college.
- Summer is a great time to get busy with your college search and application process. You should start your senior year with a list of 4-5 colleges where you want to apply.
- Be prepared for college applications: Common App – Get started ASAP. We will meet with you early next year to go over the application process and to answer any questions you might have. Now is also a great time to make sure that you can log onto your Naviance account. This is where you will request your transcripts to be sent along with your college applications. As a reminder, your Username is your student ID Number, the numbers only.
- Be thinking of teachers you would want to write a letter of recommendation for you. Ask them this spring, so they can start working on it over the summer. Brag sheets are available in student services, if you want to complete it and give to your teachers when asking.
- The last day to make a “change of mind” schedule change was February 27th.
- Remember to continue checking the Student Services Schoology and sign up for Class of 2027 remind. (@lex2027 to 81010) We include lots of valuable information about summer programs, scholarships, testing and other upcoming events. We also post a lot in your Class of 2027 schoology page. Make sure you are getting those announcements. A lot of you have taken advantage of the college tours that we do. Those will continue. I encourage you to also check out the Air National Guard and the job fair as well.

- ASVAB review will be Monday, April 13th for those students who took the test before spring break.
