# Graduation Ceremony

- There is no rain date
  - Each graduate will be given 10 tickets, but you only need the tickets if the weather forces us to move inside

# Graduation Attire

- Students are required to wear their cap and gown
  - No jeans
  - No shorts
  - No t-shirts
  - No tennis shoes

# Graduation Attire

- Dress pants with a collared shirt or a dress
- Those of you that wear a dress, please keep in mind that the yellow gown is very thin (might want to avoid certain prints)
- Shoes with heels are ok, but you have to walk up a ramp to the stage!

## Approved Medals / Cords:

- High Honors Medal
  - (GPA of 3.75 or higher)
- Honors Medal
  - (GPA of 3.50 - 3.74)
- National Honor Society Cord
- National Technical Honor Society Cord
- Bio Club Cord

# Approved Medals / Cords

- ❑ Other cords provided by school sponsored clubs are not to be worn during the ceremony unless previously approved based on academic merit
- ❑ Personal, religious, political or other non-school-issued articles are not to be worn during the ceremony
- ❑ You may bring those for pictures before and/or after the ceremony if you would like

(athletic or music)

# Passing Out Diplomas

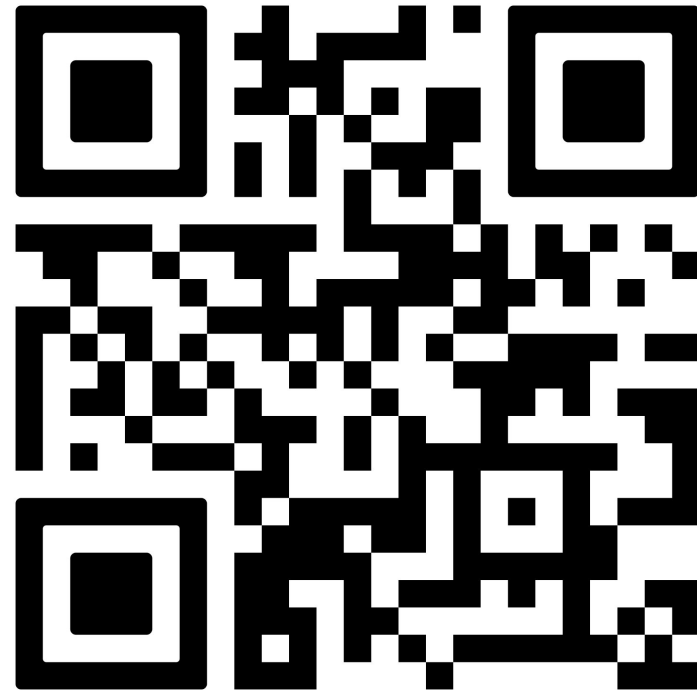
- ▣ The Class of 2026 will vote for the staff member that will pass out the diplomas
